Medical Equipment Rentals

This service is available to all that require the temporary use of walkers, wheelchairs, canes, crutches and walking poles.

Damage Deposits and Rental Fees for all equipment are due and payable before equipment is issued. The damage deposit will be reimbursed less outstanding rent fees when the equipment is returned undamaged. Equipment will not be rented for institutional use - ie personal care homes or hospitals.
